Lesson #1: Composition Lettering

Thursday, January 30 and Saturday, February 1

Get creative with FONTS and LETTERING. Work with reshape, baselines and elastic lettering.

Lesson #2: More Lettering

Thursday, February 27 and Saturday, March 1

In Creator, explore different ways to create Knock Down Lettering. In Designer, create a personalized key fob using Artwork Canvas and explore other creative techniques with lettering.

Lesson #3: Multi-Hooping for PERFECT Placement

Thursday, April 3 and Saturday, April 5

Create large embroidery designs by re-hooping the fabric as you embroider each section. With a complete understanding of what you are doing, you will achieve perfect placement.

Lesson #4: Creative Photos

Thursday, May 1 and Saturday, May 3

In Creator, make a raw edge quilted design from a photo. In Designer, use the Quilter program to create a pixel quilt from a photo.

Lesson #5: Digitizing for Special Fabrics

Thursday, June 5 and Saturday, June 7

Learn the ins and outs altering stitches for stitching on Cork, paper, leather and vinyl.

Lesson #6: Editing

Thursday, July 31 and Saturday, August 2

What's all the fuss about formats? Why the format you choose makes a difference in your editing results.

Lesson #7: Digitizing

Thursday, September 4 and Saturday, September 6

In Creator, learn how to make an edge-to-edge quilting design using the digitizing tools. In Designer, use Artwork Canvas to create block designs.

Lesson #8: Hand Look Stitching

Thursday, October 2 and Saturday, October 4

Adjusting the stitch length, angle and spacing to can creates a natural, hand-embroidered look. Change stitch settings for specialty threads. Create Cross-stitch in the Designer Level.

Lesson #9: Creative Tools

Thursday, October 30 and Saturday, November 1

Learn to make designs for use with the Needle Punch accessory and the couching Foot #43.

Lesson #10: Settings

Thursday, December 4 and Saturday, December 6

This lesson will cover the things we rarely talk about. Let's learn about underlay, pull compensation, jump stitches, starts and stops and settings for creating designs for different fabrics.
